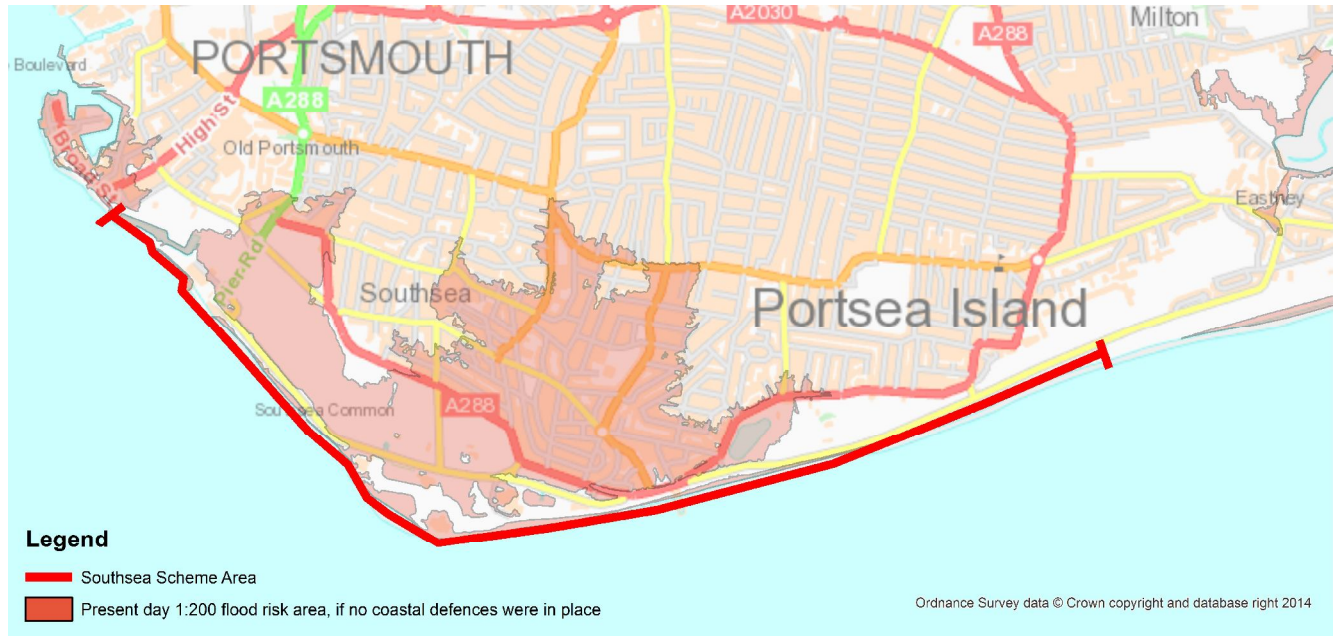


Southsea scheme area

The scheme covers 4.5km (2.8 miles) of Southsea's coastline, from the Royal Garrison Church to the Royal Marines Museum.



The scheme area has been divided into 7 sub-frontages. Each sub-frontage has a different coastal defence type and has a different character to its neighbour.

The benefit of separating the frontages is to allow flexible phasing of future construction that minimises local disruption.
